

# Ship Safety Course

## Objective

This course provides participants with a better understanding and appreciation of safety issues and reinforces safety pointers for a safe working environment onboard ship. It also highlights the onboard hazards that all should pay heed to, and the measures taken for a safe working environment onboard.

## Who Should Attend

For all Officers and crew who need to better understand and reinforce onboard safety culture.

## Course Outline

- **Safety Responsibilities / Shipboard Management**  
Risk assessment, health surveillance, safety officials, personal protective equipment and means of access and safe movements.
- **Personal Health and Safety**  
Safety induction, safety precaution, emergency procedures, living onboard and safe movement.
- **Shipboard Work Activities**  
Safe system of work, permit to work system, entering confined or enclosed spaces, use of work equipment, lifting plant, hotwork, painting, anchoring, mooring and towing operations.

## Course Methodology

Beside the lecture notes, the course will be conducted from an application viewpoint with an overview on the basic principles of Safety in line with the requirement of the ISM Code and Safe Working Practices. This one day course will include safety videos and an interactive discussion workshop on safety issues.
